**Göteborg-Landvetter airport:** There is an airport bus that takes you directly to/from the airport. See <http://www.flygbussarna.se/>



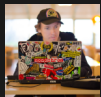
# Where to eat

Madonna. In a one hour set the duo usually clocks in over a hundred songs and combined with an endless love for all music the shows have come to look more like rock shows than the average dj-act.



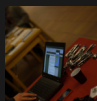
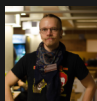
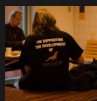
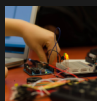
