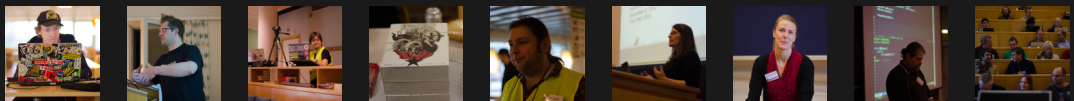


FSCONS

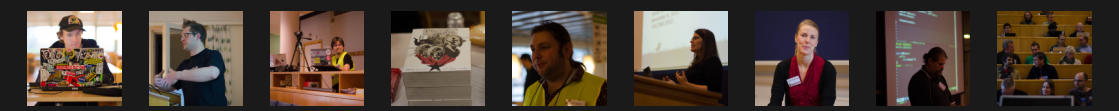

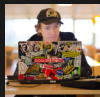

Where to eat

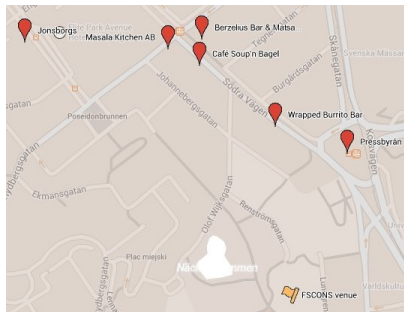
The café is open from 9h to 23 during the conference days. You can find a good selection of beers, drinks and snacks there to purchase.

We'll have juice, coffee, tea and sandwiches available for free from 9h to 10h. Coffee and tea will remain available for free for the entire day.

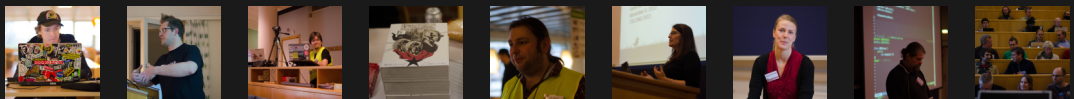

Close to the conference venue, Korsvägen is a public transport hub where you will find tram number 2, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 13 as well as many bus lines.



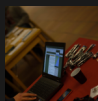
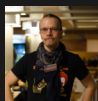
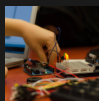
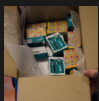
